Remember to include features like windows, doors, architraves, electrical points, plumbing, appliance spaces and all other kitchen elements. 3. Design Your Kitchen

Measuring Your Space.

How To Measure

Follow these guidelines to measure in inches. Don't forget to include the thickness of tiles if measuring existing space.



- > Find a good quality measuring tape or a digital laser device. It helps to have a second person to write measurements.
- > Use the grid on p 15 or a blank piece of paper
- > Draw the shape or floor plan or layout. Include all windows, doors, arches, structural features and appliances in plan.
- > Start with floor to ceiling height. It is easier to break into sections e.g. floor to benchtop, benchtop to ceiling, add together.
- > Measure floor to bottom of window then window height including architraves and top of window to ceiling. Include depth of window and architraves.
- > Measure wall to wall lengths and heights.
- > Appliances height and depth including fridge, oven microwave.
- > Measure sink and underneath hot and cold taps - mark waste plumbing on plan.

How To Measure?



Doors

All door measurements should include the architraves. Mark the door size, width and height as well as the width of the architrave on your plan. Also show the direction of door opening.

Windows

Window measurements need to include architraves. Include the distance from the floor to the bottom of a window and then the top of the window to the ceiling.

Walls

Walls measurements in both width and height, including bulkhead to ceiling and bulkhead to floor measurements. Nine out of ten times the bulkhead is removed for installation of overhead cabinets. Plasterers will then plaster this space following installation.

Appliances

The size of all appliances including fridge, oven, cooktops, microwave, rangehood, sink and tap will need to form part of these measurements ensuring accurate height, depth and width. Also good to mark all current and future power points.

Measuring Your Space. (Cont.)

Checklist

When measuring a wall with a door and or windows, always take the full overall wall measurement, then double check by adding the individual measurements of the doors, wall and windows.

These totals should equal that of the overall measurement. Note the position of the current sink waste on the wall or floor.

It's important to also mark the waste, hot and cold water outlets and the position of existing appliances that you plan to use in your new kitchen.

Don't forget all electrical power points, light switches and any phone or other outlets in your space.


Designing & Planning

What type of layout do you aspire to?


The layout will determine how easy your kitchen works for you and your budget. The layout of your appliances, sink, fridge and preparation areas is key to a well designed space.

When you think of cooking in your kitchen each day you know the areas you visit the most. From the fridge to preparing and cooking on the stove and then carrying hot items to the sink - all these need to be in easy reach. The placement of cabinets for ease of reach when cooking as well as benchtop space for cutting and preparing is all integral and requires careful thought.

The following are the most common layout options.


L-Shaped Kitchen

Two walls that form an L shape and often used in open style kitchen.




Straight Kitchen

One long wall for cabinets with an open space facing.




U-Shaped Kitchen

Can be wide or narrow and often long, usually with 2 walls and a return.



Galley Kitchen

Two walls opposite each other with a wall through on either end.


